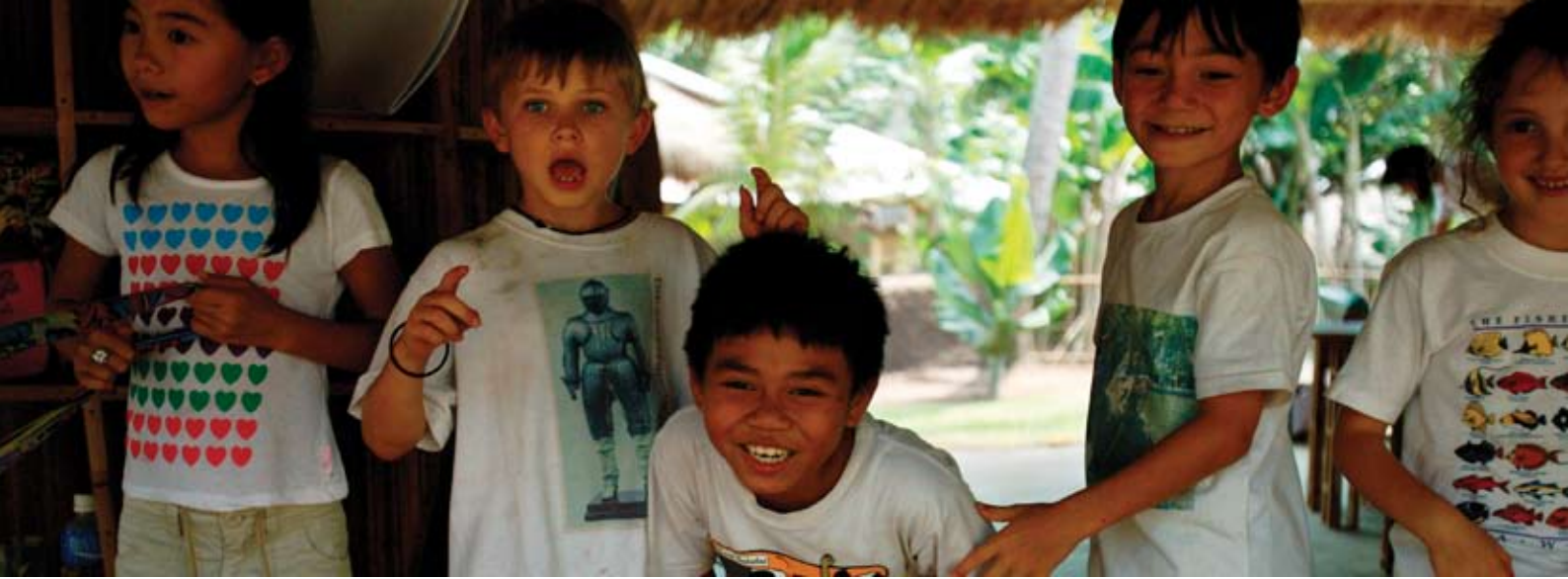

Learning at Green School takes place the moment you step foot onto our land and continues throughout our extensive campus. Green School is built upon eight hectares of land divided by the Ayung River, whose western bank supports our classrooms, library, laboratory, and auditorium, while the eastern bank serves as the setting for the School's faculty homes and will soon feature entrepreneurial enterprises, cultural centers, and guest villas. All our structures are built using sustainable natural materials such as bamboo, traditional mud walls, and *alang-alang* grass.



Our land is blanketed by a highly developed permaculture system that includes aquaculture ponds, livestock, and organic permacultural gardens. These are found throughout the extensive campus of walkways, elegantly curving bridges, and inspiring architecture.
