



Funding Opportunities

Green School will implement a wide array of projects to enhance the lives of our students, parents, faculty, and staff, and, in keeping with our holistic and regenerative approach, provide our community with an authentic experience that expands and enriches their notion of education and improves their lives. To these ends, we seek the support of generous donors at all levels. We are searching for contributors interested in helping to fund exciting initiatives that embody real needs at the School as well as achieving our underlying objective: to educate joyful, grounded, and deeply adaptable children willing and able to become the leaders of the 21st century.



Endowment for Scholarships

Our scholarship programs enhance the socio-economic and ethnic diversity of the School and the lives of our local children. Yearly gifts of tuition range from \$1,700 USD for our preschool students to \$10,250 USD for our older children. \$90,000 USD will endow a continuous scholarship at Green School in the donor's name.

Heart of School

Our Heart of School building is composed from three interconnected spirals that will stand over 20 meters high and cover 2000 square meters of floor space. It will be Bali's largest bamboo structure and quite likely it's most beautiful as well. Heart of School will house our library, computer room, classrooms, exhibition halls, offices, and much more. This project requires \$300,000 to endow the building.



Sports Facility

The facility will be constructed for Green School students and children from our surrounding local communities. This important building will ensure the physical health and well-being of our students and neighbors while enhancing kinesthetic intelligence. The facility will include a multi-purpose court and a swimming pool. We are seeking \$100,000 USD for our gym and \$80,000 USD for the swimming pool.

Coconut Oil, Soap, and Palm Sugar Production

Using the abundant organic resources on our campus, we plan to create a center to produce natural products in a sustainably managed environment. Employing local village staff, the facility will offer our students important hands-on experience in entrepreneurial pursuits. For the Center of Entrepreneurial Learning, we request \$25,000 USD for construction and staffing.



Chocolate Factory

Cacao trees abound on our campus and we hope to take advantage of this resource to open Bali's first organic, ecologically responsible chocolate factory. The size and scope of our chocolate factory will be determined by the donation we receive.

Organic Restaurant

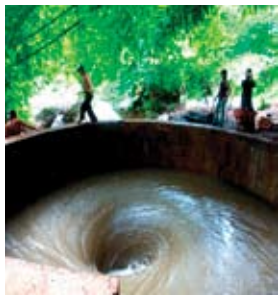
The fertile soil directly below our feet serves as the medium for the hectares of organic produce that students plant, grow, harvest, and eat. With this abundance, we plan to operate an organic restaurant, staffed by local villagers, to serve the School and local communities. This initiative will require from \$125,000 USD to endow and name this facility.





Environmental Projects

Green School serves as a model to local and international communities in how we educate our students about sustainability, as well as how profoundly environmental concerns are integrated into our learning, philosophy, and daily lives. Innovative environmental projects include the installation of a water-driven turbine, a water wheel, solar water heaters, solar panels, a wind turbine, and an organic material gasifier. For these renewable energy technologies, we are seeking \$100,000 USD to fund the total purchase and installation of the systems described above. Systems can also be funded individually.



Ropes Course

We are planning to design and construct a state-of-the-art ropes course along the Ayung River to add to the School's inspiring array of learning opportunities. Ropes courses are recognized internationally as a powerful learning tool, building team work, physical self-reliance, and risk taking. This project will require \$50,000 USD.



Mepantigan Center

Green School has quickly become a world center for Mepantigan, a form of traditional Balinese martial arts. This Center will allow students to learn more from the rich traditions of Bali, and will also be a space where students and local children can gain important physical and emotional skills as we help preserve a local art form for future generations. This project will need \$70,000 USD to endow and name the building.

Permaculture Learning Center

Our campus is blanketed by an organic permaculture system designed by international and local experts. Students are engaged in farming which connects them to the land and what it offers as well as providing them with experiential learning in the real world. In this Center, we intend to offer nutrition and health classes free of cost to our neighbors. The price of this Learning Center is \$20,000 USD, including its staffing for one year.



Medical Center for Village Children

We will create a medical clinic offering much-needed primary care services as well as providing our students with the opportunity to develop a far-stronger awareness of the complexities of western as well as Balinese and Indonesian healing traditions. For this important initiative, we request \$45,000 USD to both build and staff this facility for one year.
